Students can choose between two placement tests:
Lexile Test* that measures reading ability, and a CEFR-based,
adaptive test called BOOKR Test that evaluates listening and
reading comprehension, grammar and vocabulary.

*This feature is not available for every school.



Whichever the students choose to fill out,
they will be placed on one of 9 BOOKR levels
based on their language proficiency level.





Students can take now or later the CEFR-based, adaptive test called BOOKR Test.

The test adjusts to each student's ability in real-time by starting at a mid-level difficulty, and the difficulty of the next questions are based on the students' previous answers.

The test is available in the "My Profile" view and can be completed anytime.

The Lexile® Placement test is an assessment that provides a way to measure a student's English reading ability. By completing 30 questions, BOOKR directs students to the most relevant level out of the 9.

The test is available in the "My Profile" view and can be completed anytime.



Book Page | Recommendations, XPs and Badges

The BOOKR test is a CEFR-based, Adaptive Placement Test that adjusts to each student's ability. It starts at a mid-level difficulty and according to the student's answers, the system automatically adjusts the difficulty in real-time, meaning, the next question either stay at this mid-level, or go higher or lower. The test evaluates grammar, listening and reading comprehension. After answering the questions, the system will place the student to one of the 9 levels.

Read about the options in the 'Manage Selected' dropdown.

Add/Extend License: Assign active licenses or extend already assigned ones to your students, which you can choose from your school's purchased license pool. **Only those students who have an active license can access all content in the Library app.**

Remove License: If you would like a student not to have access to the Library app anymore or you would like to re-assign a license to another student, first remove it.

Assign Books: Choose the content you would like to assign to student(s). Once the students enter the app, they will receive a pop-up notification of the assignment, and the reading(s) will also appear in the "My Books" section.

Assign Tests: Assign your student(s) the Lexile placement test, optionally with a deadline. In the students' profile view, you can see the score and the BOOKR level (1-9) to which their English proficiency is corresponds to.

Update Level: Change your student(s) BOOKR level (1-9) based on what is corresponding to their English proficiency.

Hide Levels: If you would like to hide certain levels from the students, select the levels from the list. This will hide all the books available on that level from them.

Keep reading about the options in the 'Manage Selected' dropdown.

Unhide Levels: Unhide previously hidden levels.

Assign Student to Class: Assign students to the already created classes. **Add the same class(es) to your teacher profile to connect yourself to the students, this way they become your students, and can find them under the 'My Students' view.**

Print Student Codes: To make the login process easier for the entire class, you can download and print every students' student codes with additional information. The QR code leads to the Library application and automatically signs in the student to their account.

Export Selected Student Data: Download an Excel sheet with your student's general account data.

Delete Student: If you delete a student, all their reading data will be permanently lost and cannot be restored.


Students | Student Code

Every student has a unique, 10-digit student code that is automatically generated once the account is created.

Students need to use their codes to sign into the Library app.

Once students login to their account in the app, the system remembers them. Unless they logout when closing the app, there is no need to add their code again.

Remember, students need to have an **active license** assigned to them in order to have full reading access to the content in the app.






Students | Level Hiding

Teachers can hide levels from their students.

1 Click on the 'Add' button to choose from the 9 levels to hide.

When a level is hidden, all the content belonging to that level will not be available for the student in the app.







Every user needs to have a valid license in order to have reading access in the app.

If you are a teacher without a valid license, you do not have access to the content in the Library app, but can access the Teacher's Dashboard.

Each license has a start and end date, starting from the date your school has requested.

It's important to remember the end date of the licence and renew it before it ends.

You, as a teacher or admin, can add or remove student licenses any time. A license can be reassigned to another user as many times as a teacher wants within its expiry.

Active: Full access to the Library app and can read all the content until the expiry date.

Every user needs to have a valid license in order to have reading access in the app.

Missing: No active license, no reading access to the content in the Library app.

Not yet started: A license was assigned, but the license start date is in the future. The access will automatically start on the given date. Until then, the user does not have reading access to the content in the app.

Expired: The license has passed its expiry date. The user can still login to the Library app, but does not have reading access to the content.

Weekly Reading Report

Teachers can see which books got interacted with and by which student in at least a one week period.

- 1 Use the filter options to narrow down the list. The date filter, as a default, is at least one week, from Monday to Sunday.
- 2 Export the list into an excel sheet.
- 3 Reading time shows the amount spent in the book.
- 4 Reading session shows how many time the book was opened.
- 5 Completion shows if the book is completely read (title written in green) or not (title written in red).
- 6 Assigned shows if the book was assigned by a teacher or not.





- To play a speaking and writing game "I can" in pairs.
- To develop collaborative discussion and descriptive skills.

Skills developed during the lesson:

- Listening
- Speaking
- Reading
- Writing
- Grammar (more verb col)
- Vocabulary (abilities and actions)

Discussion starters (Lesson Plan):

Starter: "What can the robot do?" and "What can the robot not do?" Students answer in full sentences.

Students draw a simple robot and write 3 sentences about what the robot can do using can/can't. "My robot can swim." "My robot can't climb."

Students work in pairs. One student is the robot, one is a friend. They ask and answer questions: "Can you run?" "Yes, I can." "Can you fly?" "No, I can't." Rotate roles.

Clear a small space. Teacher calls out sentences using can/can't from the story or previously learned. "The robot can fly." "People can't climb mountains." Students act out abilities. Some students they can do, or pretend they can't do something they can't. Students can create their own can/can't sentences for classmates to act out.

Ask students to rate themselves: "I can talk about abilities." "I can use can in a sentence." Students hold up 1-5 fingers to show.

Teacher checks understanding and provides feedback.
